



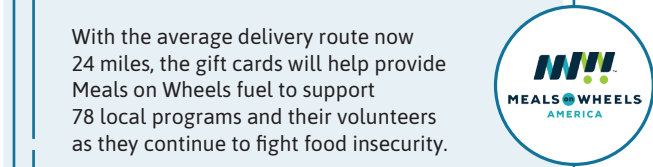
## Supporting National Partners with \$1 Million in “Gift Cards for Care”

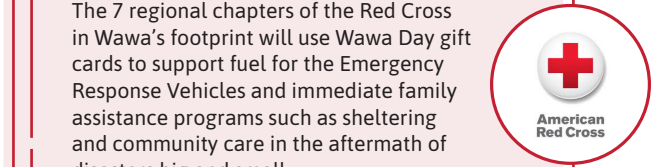
Feeding America will use gift cards to support their work to defray the increasing cost of fuel for their service vehicles and to support programs aimed at children, veterans, active military personnel, seniors and families in need.



With the average delivery route now 24 miles, the gift cards will help provide Meals on Wheels fuel to support 78 local programs and their volunteers as they continue to fight food insecurity.



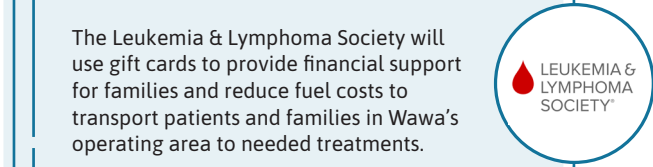
With 17 Children’s Hospital partners in Wawa’s market area, the gift cards will be used to help patients and families fight food insecurities and cover transportation costs during treatments. Gift cards will also be used to cover fuel costs related to patient transfers between service areas.



The 7 regional chapters of the Red Cross in Wawa’s footprint will use Wawa Day gift cards to support fuel for the Emergency Response Vehicles and immediate family assistance programs such as sheltering and community care in the aftermath of disasters big and small.



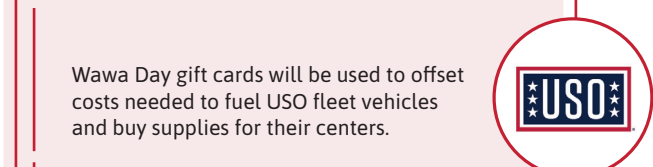
Special Olympics state chapters will use gift cards to support important programs and services for athletes, volunteer coaches and families, including fuel for transportation to and from competition events and practices. Gift cards will also be used to provide food for Special Olympics families experiencing financial challenges.



The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society will use gift cards to provide financial support for families and reduce fuel costs to transport patients and families in Wawa’s operating area to needed treatments.



Gift cards will support families in need who have received a new diagnosis of type 1 diabetes. Families will use cards for transportation needs and to purchase nutritious food to help offset additional expenses and higher costs.



Wawa Day gift cards will be used to offset costs needed to fuel USO fleet vehicles and buy supplies for their centers.
